Autism Assessments

Assessment Needed	Hours Total (Face to Face & Reporting)	Cost
Autism Assessment (Full Diagnosis + Severity Level)	6.5 Hours	\$975 ²
Autism Assessment (Severity Level Only) ¹	5.5 Hours	\$825 ²

¹ Previous diagnosis of an Autism Spectrum Disorder (Asperger's, and PDD-NOS included) is required.

² For children under 13 years of age - Medicare rebates may be available through the Medicare *Helping Children with Autism* Scheme. Four assessment sessions are rebated at the request of a paediatrician or psychiatrist to aid in the diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder. Other Assessments

Assessment Needed	Hours Total (Face to Face & Reporting)	Cost
Cognitive (Intelligence Only) Assessment	4 Hours	\$600
Autism (Full Diagnosis + Severity) + Cognitive (Intelligence)	9 Hours	\$1350
Autism (Severity) + Cognitive (Intelligence)	8.5 Hours	\$1275

Additions (Can be added to an Assessment)

Assessment Needed	Hours Total (Face to Face & Reporting)	Cost
ADHD Assessment	0.5 Hours	\$75 ³

³ ADHD assessments are not being done as standalone assessments, and can only be added to other assessments (Autism or Cognitive).

All assessments include a Parent/Caregiver meeting, and will also assess other mental health conditions (e.g., Anxiety, Depression, and Stress). Information will be collected from the parent/caregivers, as well as participant (no matter what age). If you have any concerns not listed, please talk to the psychologist completing your assessment.



Psychology Assessment Information

Autism Advisory and Support Service (AASS) offers psychological assessment to provide detailed information for autism diagnoses, cognitive and intellectual functioning, developmental difficulties, and other mental health conditions. These assessments will determine the necessary interventions, strategies and supports that will assist someone to reach their potential, as well as identify their strengths, talents, and interests.

Psychological assessments are conducted by our trained Psychologist, and will be provided on an individual basis. Autism diagnostic assessments can be conducted, and then will need to be validated by a Paediatrician or Psychiatrist.
