Cancellation Policy

This Cancellation Policy applies to all clients from 1 July, 2022 and replaces our previous cancellation policies.

Cancellation Fees of 100% of the service fee will be charged when:

- You fail to advise or fail to show up for a service (no show).
- You notify us of cancelling an appointment within seven (7) full days of, or on the day of the <u>service</u> being provided (short notice).

Please contact the office on (02)9601 2844 (leave a message if unattended) or call or text your therapist directly. We ask that you contact us as soon as you can in relation to any cancellation regardless of location of therapy (clinic, school or home-based therapy). It is the carer's responsibility to advise AASS if school-based therapy cannot occur for any reason (e.g. school carnivals, excursions etc).

Cancellation Fees will be charged as follows:

Cancellation Timeframe	Cancellation Fee
Cancel more than seven (7) full days before the appointment	No charge
Cancel within seven (7) full days of the appointment (short notice)	100% of session fee (NDIS Clients - charged to the NDIS plan)
Failing to Advise or "No Show" for appointment	100% of NDIS session fee (NDIS Clients - charged to the NDIS plan)

ALL CANCELLATION FEES (SELF MANAGED NDIS) MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE NEXT THERAPY SESSION.

Cancellation or Suspension of Services:

Your services may be cancelled if:

- You reach <u>more than 6 cancellations</u> in a calendar year
- Fees and/or Cancellation Fees are unpaid or in arrears

To reduce cancellations, AASS sends out scheduled SMS reminders of your scheduled appointments if you provide a mobile phone contact number.

When <u>three cancellations</u> are reached, AASS staff will attempt to contact you to determine what is affecting your continuity of service and discuss if alternative arrangements or extra support is needed in relation to your services at AASS.
