





Work Prep Connect Program

The purpose of the 10 week Work Prep Connect Program is to provide an opportunity to eligible participants who have experienced barriers in accessing employment, the community or tertiary education. In this case the industries will be Hospitality (coffee) and Retail. The Work Prep Connect Program will also equip participants with valuable employment skills through practical, hands-on training.

TAFE assists in delivering training via non accredited learning while being fully supported by AASS Staff. There are no assessments & participants will receive a Certificate of Recognition at the end of the program. Participants must be 17+ and not enrolled in school.
