Autism and Neurodiversity Diagnostic Assessment

A diagnostic assessment focusing on identifying the autistic neurotype. Screeners for ADHD and mental health diagnoses provided. This assessment comes with a summary report which provides an overview of the diagnoses provided and current support needs.

Autism re-assessment

Provided when you have previously been assessed for autism and need to update your current support needs/level. This assessment comes with a summary report which provides an overview of the diagnoses provided and current support needs.

Other Stand-Alone Assessments

Assessment	Cost
Cognitive Assessment – comprehensive report provided	\$1,400
Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Assessment – diagnostic report and recommendations	\$1,000

All assessments include a thorough initial interview and follow up session (face to face or telehealth options available). All assessments will be completed within a neurodiversity affirming practice.

Deposit

A deposit of 20% is required at the time of booking your assessment. Your booking will be confirmed once your deposit is paid and the funds have cleared, or a payment receipt is received.

Cancellation Policy

If you cancel within 7 days of your scheduled appointment, your deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations made more than 7 days in advance are eligible for a full refund of the deposit or may be rescheduled without penalty. If you have any concerns, please call us to discuss your options.

Medicare Rebates

For people under 25 years of age - Medicare rebates may be available. Four assessment sessions are rebated at the request of a paediatrician or psychiatrist to aid in the diagnosis of Autism. Psychology Assessment Information

Autism Advisory and Support Service (AASS) offers psychological assessment to provide detailed information for autism diagnoses, cognitive and intellectual functioning, developmental differences, and other mental health conditions. These assessments will determine the necessary interventions, strategies and supports that will assist someone to reach their potential, as well as identify their strengths, talents, and interests. Reports and assessments will be completed in a neurodiversity affirming manner, providing a space for people to be genuinely themselves. AASS are happy to accommodate differences in communication, movement / mobility, and accessibility to services. Please reach out if you need further support with completing the assessment, including telehealth services, wheelchair access, or other needs.

Psychological assessments are conducted by a trained Psychologist, and will be provided on an individual basis. Autism diagnostic assessments can be conducted for all ages, starting from 3 years of age. Please contact AASS to determine whether the assessment process will be suitable for your needs.
